I have read through and redacted all applications. Here is a link to the folder in Google for scholarship reviewers. In the "Blind Review" folder via Google, you will find your name, and then your assigned number for a redacted application. If the application pertains to a performance you will also see a second file with an mp3 of the student's submission.

GOAL DUE DATE: As soon as you're able to turn the application around. Notification of will go out to families and districts within a few days after all reviewers are finished. We are also trying to put a summary article in OAGC's *Review* winter publication so it has moved our timetable up a bit.

1) Scoring Rubric: The student is competing against the rubric. Do not feel the need to inflate scores based on the low number of applicants. The rubric is attached to this email and is also available through the Blind Review folder. The top two-thirds of the rubric covers basic application elements. The bottom piece is specific to the area of visual/performing arts being evaluated, to provide a total score out of 25.

2) Student Applications: Each student has randomly been assigned a number, then re-sorted into numeric order. Personal and school-identifying information has been removed from the applications. Grade and age have been left. Be sure to refer to this prior to reading the essays, as the essay should reflect **age-appropriate expectations** for writing.

3) Scoring Google Sheet: This is a shared document between all of us. Enter in each applicant's rubric scores. Applicants are listed by their assigned number (file name).
